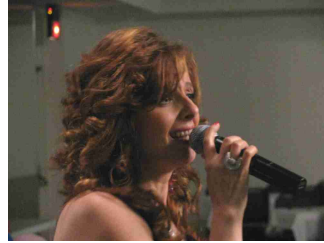

St. Rita of Cascia
Feastday May 22

St. Rita was born near Spoleto, Italy, in 1381. From a young age she wanted to become a nun. Her elderly parents insisted that she be married at the age of twelve to a man who was cruel and harsh. She had two sons and was finally widowed when her husband was killed in a brawl. Both sons also died. Rita was, still anxious to become a nun, but could not join the Augustines because she was a widow and was not a virgin. Finally, in 1413, the order gave her entry, and she earned fame for her austerity, devotion to prayer, and charity.

In the midst of chronic illnesses, she received visions and wounds on her forehead which resembled the crown of thorns. She died on May 22 at Cascia, and many miracles were reported instantly
