Love One Another



Jesus knew that he was going to leave his disciples; he knew that the only way to stay among us would be through His ‘Ascension’ and by sending the Holy Spirit to make each one of us another *Christ* to continue what he had already started.

As a father giving his last testament, Jesus gave us His new and final commandment:

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

There is no other choice in our life than to love. ‘Love’ becomes **the sign and mark of our discipleship**. But in what sense is this new? *For the command itself of love was very old* (Lev 19:18). ‘The new’ in this commandment is not only to love each other but to love each other **as** Jesus himself loved us. **Love becomes the Christian distinctive and the school of Jesus**.

When we pay attention to our remarks and/or language, when we behave a bit differently at work or church or school or with family or friends, are bit more open, caring, more accepting, more loving, more attentive than normal we are showing the effects of our faith (first reading). Love is always received as a gift. It also needs to be demonstrated in accordance with Christ's command.

Love changes lives. I pray that you Parishioners may be **more like your Jesus!** I pray that God, as St. Paul said in the reading: “may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better”. God loves you; so do I.

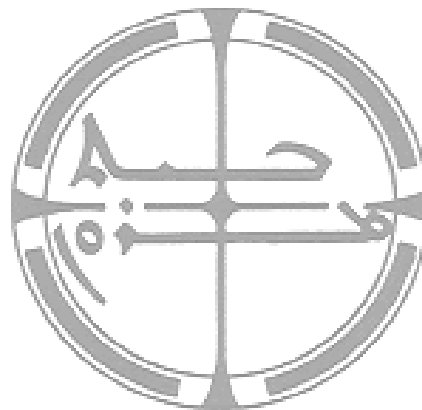

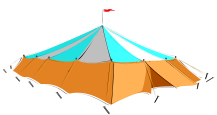

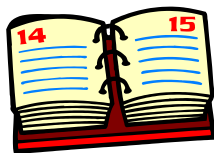
The tickets are \$1 each, 6 for \$5 or 25 for \$20. Ursula Kadadu will be in the hall if you would like to pick up tickets to sell.

Feastday June 10

St. Barnabas

Saint Barnabas (born Joseph) was an Early Christian convert and one of the earliest Christian disciples in Jerusalem. Barnabas was a Levite and a native of Cyprus, where he possessed land. He was converted to Christianity shortly after Pentecost (about A.D. 29 or 30) and immediately sold his property and devoted the proceeds to the apostles in Jerusalem who gave him a new name – Barnabas meaning “son of the prophet”. He was one of the first teachers of the church at Antioch. When Saint Paul returned to Jerusalem after his conversion, Barnabas took him and introduced him to the apostles. He and Saint Paul undertook missionary journeys together. They gained many converts in Antioch and traveled together making more converts. Barnabas and Paul successfully evangelized among the "God-fearing" gentiles who attended synagogues in various cities of modern day Turkey. St. Barnabas also participated in the Council of Jerusalem where he defended Gentile converts against a faction promoting Gentile circumcision.
