“My Hour Has Not Yet Come”

“*Vanity of vanities, all is vanity*” said the Preacher in Ecclesiastes (Ecl 1:2). Everything human is vain; for man, during his life on earth, is more transient than all things in nature. But with Jesus, **everything becomes meaningful**, even our death. Jesus didn’t just remind and renew the meaning for our life, but He became our purpose and its motivator. For everything there is a time, and enough time for every purpose in life. But we have just to believe and keep faith until the hour comes.

This Sunday marks the end of the Fat week and the *Sunday of the Entrance into Lent*. The readings remind us that our life “*is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit*”. **It is a matter of Faith** Faith is the purpose of the miracle of Cana. Faith is the reason John wrote the book (20:31). Faith is why we preach. Homilies are not political essays designed to enlighten the crowd and produce enough guilt to get them to recycle their wine bottles, but to communicate faith in Jesus Christ. **Good works are by-products of faith. Faith is an overwhelming gift in which the Giver Himself resides.**

Lent is a time of prayers, fasting and performing works of Charity. We will never recognize what we own, have and enjoy until we stop having them. When we stop eating something that we like, we should be thankful to God for it and share it with those that don’t have it. **Lent is time of choice** there is a world of difference between God and the devil. If you resist God, you will destroy yourself, but if you resist the devil, you will destroy him. If Jesus’ hour was when he offered himself for us on the Cross, **when does our hour start?** What are my plans and goals for renewal this 2011 Lent?

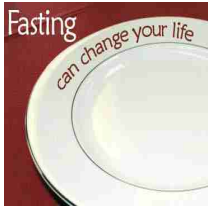

LENTEN FAST & ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS

It is now time for us to begin our Lenten season. This Monday is Ash Monday, and the Church recommends that all people ages 14 to 65 fast and abstain from meat and meat products on all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting and abstinence from food and drink except water and medicine is demanded from midnight until noon on Ash Monday and Good Friday, and on all the days of Lent for those who can do it. Those unable to fast because of health are required to perform an act of charity.

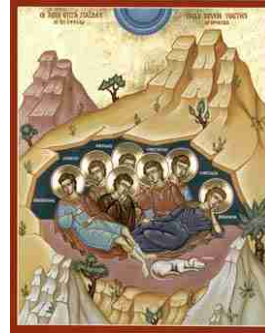

The Seven Men of Ephesus

Feastday: March 7



The Seven Men of Ephesus "The seven sleepers were natives of Ephesus. The Emperor Decius, who persecuted the Christians, came to Ephesus and ordered the erection of temples in the city.

Seven young Christian men, refused to sacrifice to the idols, and remained in their houses praying and fasting.

They were accused before Decius, and they confessed themselves to be Christians. The Emperor gave them a little time to consider what line their choice.

They took advantage of this reprieve to give their goods to the poor. They then went to Mount Celion, to hide. "Decius, thinking they might be hiding in a cave, blocked up the mouth with stones so they would die of hunger."

The seven men fell asleep, miraculously waking up three hundred and sixty years later, around 435 in the time of Theodosius II. They wandered into the city of Ephesus, amazed at all the churches and the freedom of worship for Christians. The Sleepers later died naturally and were buried in the cave in which they had slept.

This miracle was apparently first described by Bishop Stephen of Ephesus who used it to dispel the controversy having to do with the resurrection of the body.
